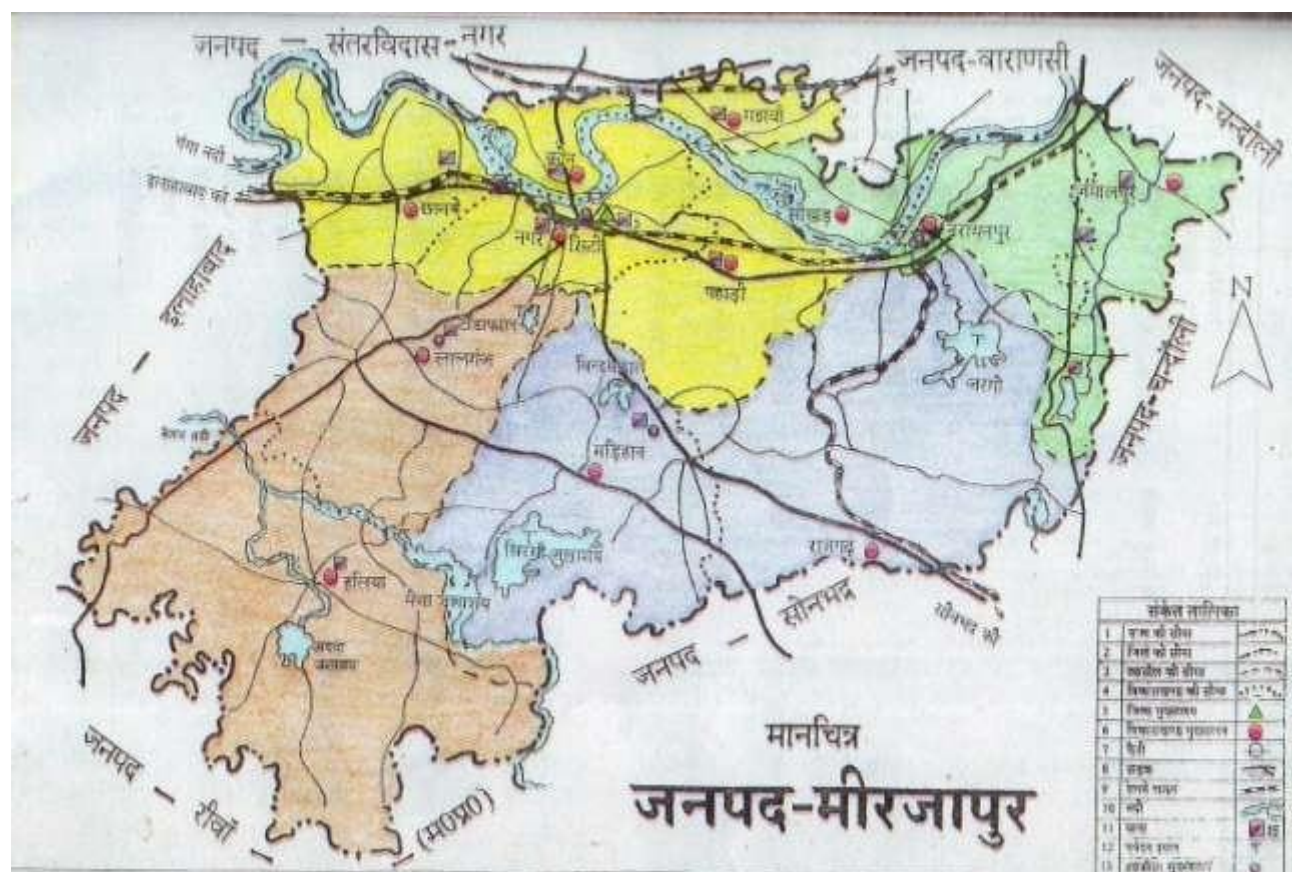


# DISTRICT ENVIRONMENT PLAN FOR DISTRICT MIRZAPUR UTTAR PRADESH



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## 1.0 District Profile

Mirzapur district is in vicinity of district Allahabad, Sant Ravidas nagar (Bhadohi), Chandauli, Varanasi, Sonbhadra of Uttar Pradesh and district, Rewa and Sidhi of Madhya Pradesh. River Ganga flows through the northern boundary of the District. District Mirzapur is divided into two biogeographic zones- Gangetic plains in northern portion and Vindhyan hills series which constitute major part of the district. The Vindhyan plateau of Mirzapur are known for their dry deciduous forest, waterfalls and wildlife. The elevation ranges from approx. 1 km near river Ganga to as high as 65 km near Dramandganj forest range. The terrain is undulating with small to medium height of hills in between. There is rocky sandstone layer beneath the soil and in some places that is exposed to surface.

In 2009, the Ministry of Environment & Forests (MoEF), Govt. of India in association with Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), New Delhi and Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), New Delhi have carried out an environmental assessment of industrial clusters across the country named "Comprehensive Environmental Pollution Index" (CEPI) with the aim of identifying polluted industrial clusters & prioritizing planning needs for intervention to improve the quality of environment in these industrial clusters and the nation as a whole. ### a. District Administrative Set-up

Administratively, the district is divided into four major tehsils namely Mirzapur Sadar, Lalganj, Chunar and Marihan. These four tehsils are further divided into 12 blocks. Chanbey, Kon, Majhwa, Nagar [City] and Pahari (Under Sadar Tehsil), Haliya and Lalganj (Under Lalganj Tehsil), Patehara and Rajgarh (Under Marihan Tehsil), Jamalpur, Narayanpur, Rajgar and Sikhad (Under Chunar Tehsil). These Blocks are further divided into 809 Gram Panchayats and 2079 revenue villages. The whole district comes under the Mirzapur Lok Sabha seat while there are five assembly constituencies in the district.



## **b. Geography & Demography**

The climate of the district could be described as semi-arid. The average annual rainfall in the district is 724.00mm. (63.84%) The average annual of Mirzapur district is 1105.20 mm. The rivers, Ganga, Jargo, Karnawati and garai bordering the district on the north and south, along with their tributaries play an important role in fashioning the topography of the district. The levels of G.T. Road which traverses the district from north-west to south-east, illustrate the fall perhaps more clearly, the greatest height being 15 Km. Near the western border and the lowest 10 km. Near the eastern border, the intermediate levels being 10 Km at Sant ravidas Nagar (Bhadohi), 45 km at Prayagraj, 55 km at Chandauli and 69 Km At Sonbhadra. Geologically the district is formed by Sub-Recent to Recent rocks composed of the sand stone deposits.

Mirzapur district of Uttar Pradesh has a total population of 24,96,970 as per the Census 2011. Out of which 13,12,302 are males while 11,84,668 are females. In 2011 there were a total of 472,238 families residing in Mirzapur district. The Average Sex Ratio of Mirzapur is 896. As per Census 2011 out of total population, 13.8% people live in urban areas while 86.2% lives in the rural areas. The average literacy rate in urban areas is 69% while that in the rural areas is 61%. Also, the Sex Ratio of urban areas in Mirzapur district is 905 while that of rural areas is 887. While the child sex ratio of Mirzapur is 906 which is greater than average sex ratio (896).

## **c. Land-use pattern**

The land of Mirzapur is pretty fertile depending on soil depth which makes agricultural usage of land as a modest use. The land usage pattern in Mirzapur resembles like that of Bundelkhand region specially chitrakoot. The census of 2011 highlights the following features of land use pattern:
